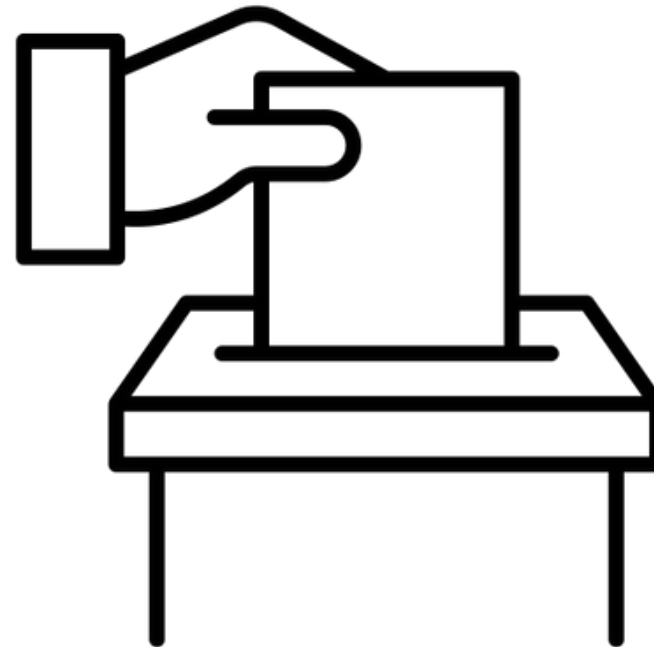

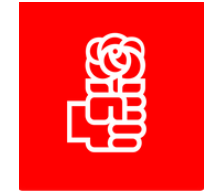
- **Immediate** and priority **expulsion of illegal** immigrants and legal immigrants who commit serious **crimes** or are repeat offenders
- Total **elimination** of social assistance, **subsidies** and benefits for immigrants in an irregular situation and for **NGOs** working in rescue or migration assistance
- Legal reform to prevent fraud in immigration or asylum matters



SPANISH SOCIALIST WORKER'S PARTY

PRIMARY MEASURES

- 1 - Objective: orderly, safe and humane migration based on respect for human rights and international cooperation.
- 2 - Strengthen recruitment in countries of origin and improve the management of migration flows, in order to reduce irregular arrivals and promote legal channels of entry.
- 3 - Promote the reform of the Immigration Regulations, facilitating employment ties, residence for training purposes and the incorporation of migrants into the labour market.
- 4 - Gradually close the Foreigners' Detention Centres (CIE), replacing them with dignified reception alternatives with legal guarantees.
- 5 - Regularise migrants who already live and work in Spain, especially those in vulnerable situations or with proven roots.
- 6 - Create a new State Plan for Integration and Coexistence, with specific funds for autonomous communities and local councils.



PRIMARY MEASURES

- 1 - Create a single authority to coordinate all migration policy and end fragmentation between ministries.
- 2 - Establish a points-based visa system based on merit and integration, and reject mass regularisations.
- 3 - Strengthen border control with more resources, technology and European collaboration to curb irregular immigration.
- 4 - Zero tolerance policy towards crime and mafias, toughening penalties and facilitating rapid expulsions.
- 5 - Understand integration as a demanding process, where learning the language and respecting the values of the country are essential requirements.
- 6 - Link social assistance to legal residence and effort, reserving permanent residence for those who can prove they are working and are truly integrated.



PRIMARY MEASURES

- 1 - Immediate and priority expulsion of all immigrants who enter Spain illegally, as well as those who, even with legal residence, commit serious crimes or repeat minor offences.
- 2 - Total ban on regularisation and public aid for immigrants in an irregular situation
- 3 - Closure of centres for unaccompanied foreign minors (MENAs) considered to be problematic and immediate repatriation of minors to their families or countries of origin.
- 4 - Elimination of subsidies to NGOs and associations that, according to VOX, promote or facilitate illegal immigration, along with harsher penalties for mafias and their collaborators.
- 5 - Suspension of development cooperation with countries that do not cooperate in the return of immigrants or in the control of their borders.
- 6 - All subsidies and benefits must require legal residence and give preference to Spanish citizens.

PRIMARY MEASURES

- 1 - Closure of Foreigners' Detention Centres (CIE) throughout the country, as they are considered incompatible with human rights and a method of criminalising migration
- 2 - Comprehensive reform of the Organic Law on the Rights and Freedoms of Foreigners in Spain and their Social Integration to establish a permanent regularisation procedure and simplify formalities
- 3 - Quota system for the participation of migrants and refugees in public institutions, companies and organisations as part of a policy of diversity and inclusion
- 4 - Digital inclusion and simplification of immigration and international mobility procedures, with in-person and online assistance
- 5 - Demand the immediate extraordinary regularisation of approximately 500,000 migrants through a Popular Legislative Initiative
